



2026 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION GUIDELINES

Amount of Scholarship Award:

Up to four \$2,000 scholarships will be awarded.

Eligibility:

This scholarship is open to high school seniors who are San Luis Obispo County residents. At the time of application, an applicant must be enrolled in, or accepted to attend as a full-time student, an accredited college or university, or a full-time industrial arts or technical training institution to study agriculture, industrial arts or engineering, or public safety. Preference will be given to those students with an articulated interest or history of involvement in the sport of rodeo, in addition to the formal coursework outlined above.

Application Process:

Applications will be accepted between February 1, 2026 and March 31, 2026. All materials, including references letters and transcripts, must be postmarked via US Mail or submitted via email/online by March 31, 2026 to be considered. Candidates will be notified of the Committee's decision by April 15, 2026. The application timeline is as follows:

- 1.) Application Window: February 1, 2026 to March 31, 2026.
- 2.) Winner Notification: April 15, 2026.
- 3.) Recognition at Sheriff's Rodeo: May 9, 2026.

The complete application must consist of the following:

- 1.) The application form (four pages).
- 2.) An official transcript from high school(s) attended for all work through December 31, 2025.
- 3.) Three letters of recommendation.
